PRE-REQUESTING YOUR TOURS

How to pre-request your tours prior to boarding the ship:

ONLINE:

Tours may be pre-requested online up to 120 days prior to your sailing date (but not before).

USING A FAX:

Alternately you will receive a booking form together with this shore excursion booklet and cruise documents. Complete the form and fax it to the number indicated at the top of the form.

In using the online Shore Excursion Request, you will receive an email acknowledgement of receipt listing your requested excursions and this is the recommended method. The fax system is unable to generate an acknowledgement of receipt. Please bring your faxed copy or email copy with you to the ship. Please note that neither automated system can respond to questions. Requests will be processed in the order received. Many tours are limited; but every effort will be made to accommodate your request. Actual confirmation and ticket distribution will take place onboard.

TOUR PRICING:

Tour pricing can be found on our website (120 days prior to sailing date) and also on the pre-request form included with documentation.

TOUR SYMBOLS

To assist in your tour selection, please note the symbol indicated beside each tour description. These symbols represent the following:

SEATED SYMBOL

Although primarily sightseeing tours, these excursions do include walking for short distances over relatively level terrain. They also may include getting into/out of a helicopter or floatplane.

WALKING SYMBOL

Tours include walking at sites, or periods of sitting or standing.

HIKING SYMBOL

Tours with difficult or extensive walking and/or steps. Also tours of long duration which can become tiring.

ADVENTURE SYMBOL

For the adventurous – these are our most active tours, including biking, hiking, kayaking, horseback riding, river rafting, scuba, snorkeling, or tours which require you to be physically fit to be able to enjoy.

CONCIERGE CHOICE SYMBOL

This tour will provide guests with the exclusive opportunity to experience and explore areas considered to be more specialized or unique to this port of call. In some cases, the tour may be a light adventure and therefore more active. Please read the description carefully and make your request early to avoid disappointment.

WHEELCHAIR SYMBOL

This symbol indicates tours that can accommodate guests (with proper notice) who utilize a wheelchair and have limited mobility. Most tour operators require that wheelchairs be collapsible. Space restrictions may preclude transport of electric wheelchairs and walkers. Please notify The Travel Concierge onboard the ship so that arrangements may be made prior to your arrival in port.

WATER SYMBOL

Beach, snorkel and water-related tours.

- Wear your swimsuit under a cover-up, protect yourself from the sun and bring a towel from the ship.
- The sun can be strong, we recommend that you wear sunglasses, suntan lotion, a hat and long sleeve T-shirts if you are sensitive to the sun.
- Wear reef shoes or other closed-in shoes to protect yourself from coral and other sharp material in the water.
- We recommend bringing only waterproof cameras or disposable cameras as you may get wet even during the boat portion of the tour.

HEADPHONES SYMBOL

Guests will be provided with headphones to accompany select tours to clearly broadcast their guide's live commentary. Availability of headsets is limited, and this service cannot be guaranteed.

SPECIAL EVENT SYMBOL

Special event included for all guests with our compliments.

DIVING SYMBOL

For certified divers and Discovery Scuba. Discovery Scuba is for those who have never tried scuba diving before.

IJOURNEY WALKING TOURS

Talks will be downloaded to your personal iPod or MP3 player, if you do not have one there will be a limited number on board.

A map will also be provided. The pace of the walks is steady and fairly easy, the narrator will invite you to pause the talk if you are not keeping pace so the program will fit all levels of walking ability.

Please remember to keep a look out when crossing roads and in crowded areas. Also take care when walking on cobbled or uneven surfaces. Volume should be kept at a level so that it does not shut out other sounds such as traffic.

The cost of the tour does not include transportation to the starting point of the walk. Please see the Travel Concierge, who will be happy to suggest ways of getting you to the location to start your walking tour.
